



What about the Post-9/11 GI Bill?

The Post 9/11 GI Bill can go a long way in helping you pay for Excelsior College. Veterans' benefits include:

- Tuition and fees paid directly to the school
- Monthly Housing Allowance (MHA): Veterans must attend college greater than half-time to full-time. To obtain your degree from an online college and receive the full monthly housing stipend, you must also take a course at a local traditional college each term you take online course. The full monthly housing stipend is based on the zip code of your local college
- Solely online Monthly Housing Allowance: Veterans pursuing classes through distance learning may receive MHA by attending college greater than half-time to full-time. The housing allowance is half the national average BAH for an E-5 with dependents
- Annual books and supplies stipend of up to \$1,000 based on enrollment
- One-time rural benefit payment for eligible individuals

Recognition
