NOTE: The issuance date of the transcript must be within three weeks or less. Do not submit unofficial copies as they cannot be used to evaluate your prior credits.

Submission of TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) with a minimum score of 525 on the paper-based test or 69 on the Internet-based test; MELAB (Michigan English Language Assessment Battery) with a minimum score of 75, or IELTS (International English Language Testing System) with a minimum overall band score of 5.5. NOTE: Test must have been taken within the last two years of applying to Excelsior College.
- 2. Successful completion of Excelsior College's ENGx111: English Composition or the UExcel® ENGx110 College Writing examination.
- 3. Submission of evidence of the successful completion of at least 9 credit hours of academic work in courses delivered in English at an institution of higher education in the United States.

International Nurses Only

In addition to official transcripts, nursing candidates must demonstrate that they have an equivalent U.S. Registered Nurse (RN) licensure. To be eligible for admission, the applicant must be a graduate from an approved school of nursing in their country of education and hold a current, unencumbered nursing license (if licensed in multiple jurisdictions and/or countries, all licenses must be unencumbered). All nursing school transcripts and all licenses will be validated by primary source verification.

International candidates must apply to the Commission on Graduate of Foreign Nursing Schools (CGFNS) New York Credential Verification Service (NYCVS) and the New York State Education Department (NYSED) to have their foreign nursing education evaluated and approved by the aforementioned organizations. Since NYSED only issues an official NCLEX eligibility document to applicants directly, and will not send the document to Excelsior College, international applicants must forward the unopened official NCLEX eligibility document to Excelsior College. When international applicants receive the official NYSED document in its sealed envelope, they must insert the unopened envelope into an outer envelope and forward it to Excelsior College. International applicants should also write their full name, permanent address, and date of birth on the outer envelope.

For the evaluation of credentials from outside the United States, all applicants must use one of the approved agencies noted previously. CGFNS New York Credential Verification Service (NYCVS) and the International Consultants of Delaware (ICD) Course by Course Services are offering Excelsior College applicants a discount when using their combined services. This bundle service package represents significant savings with a discount being applied to the ICD Course by Course Service. This one-stop service helps applicants reduce expenses and save time in completing all the required procedures necessary for admission. All official documents must be in sealed envelopes from the original source. In the event that Excelsior College receives an opened document, it will be considered unofficial and will not be considered for eligibility or evaluation; the opened document will be returned to the applicant. In this case, it becomes the applicant's responsibility to contact NYSED or ICD and request another official copy to be forwarded, unopened, to Excelsior College by the applicant.

Guidelines for the Admissions Essay

The admissions essay is your opportunity to explain your interest in earning a Master of Arts in Liberal Studies from Excelsior College. The essay is the primary means by which your preparedness for the program will be assessed. In a direct and concise essay of 800-1200 words (or about 150-250 words per question) respond to the following five questions:

1. How can you achieve your personal, vocational, and/or educational goals within the structure of the Master of Arts in Liberal Studies program?

(Consider: How will this degree advance your personal, vocational, and educational interests? Why do you want to earn this particular graduate degree? Explain your understanding of the structure of the program. Is the anticipated average time for completing the program [2–3 years] appropriate for your goals?)

2. What is your preparedness for, and understanding of, graduate-level study in the arts and sciences?

(Consider: What appeals to you about interdisciplinary study? What appeals to you about graduate-level study? How has your undergraduate education prepared you for this program? What arts and science disciplines interest you, and why? What are the connections between the arts and sciences and your vocation? What intellectual interests have you pursued outside of formal schooling?)

3. Do you have an area of focus — a topic, problem, historical period, question, or the like — that you wish to explore while in the program?

(If you have an area of focus in mind, please give details. Have you already taken courses, studied independently, or have learning acquired non-traditionally, within this area? If not, what courses or independent study do you need to take?)

4. What is your experience in, and/or aptitude for, completing academic work at a distance?

(Consider: Have you taken online courses, correspondence courses or pursued independent study? How do you study and learn outside of a traditional classroom setting? What kind of academic library access do you have?)

5. What special abilities, qualities, or life experiences will you bring to the program?

Note: Because good writing skills will be very important for your success, the essay will be used to assess your ability to communicate effectively in writing. Therefore, the essay should represent your best writing effort.

The following criteria will guide the Admissions Committee in its assessment of your essay:

- 1. Is the MA in Liberal Studies appropriate for your vocational or personal goals?
- 2. Is your proposed academic program appropriate for the MA in Liberal Studies? Has your essay demonstrated that you understand the program?
- 3. Do you demonstrate the necessary writing skills, motivation, academic preparation, and intellectual maturity to succeed in the program?
- 4. Are you capable of successfully completing your proposed program?

2. How does the Homeland Security and Emergency Management concentration relate to your previous experience and/or future goals?

(Please provide some information about why are you interested in the Homeland Security and Emergency Management concentration. Have you already taken classes, studied independently, or have professional experience within this area?)

3. What is your preparedness for, and understanding of, graduate-level study in Criminal Justice?

(Consider: What is your understanding of graduatelevel study and how is it different from undergraduate study? How has your undergraduate degree prepared *you for this program?)*

4. What is your experience in, and/or aptitude for, completing academic work at a distance?

(Have you taken online courses, correspondence courses, or pursued independent study? How do you study and learn outside of a traditional classroom setting? Do you foresee any challenges to completing *your degree online?)*

5. The essay helps our faculty and advisors to get to know you better. Please tell us anything else you consider important.

(Consider: What special abilities, qualities, or life experiences will you bring to the program? Are there any challenges you have had to overcome? If you had any challenges in your academic career, please explain how you will address these challenges during your graduate degree.)
