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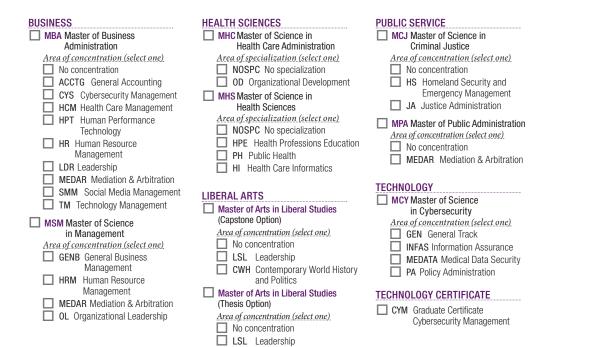

In the pursuit of graduate education, a student's ability to communicate effectively in writing is an absolute necessity. Specific to MALS: MALS candidates must submit a well-written essay of 800–1200 words. The essay should be creative and address career goals, academic preparedness, and previous online course experience.

The MALS program offers students the option of a thesis or capstone. The essay should indicate your preference. If pursuing the thesis option, candidate should discuss areas of potential thesis research.

Specific to MSCJ and MPA: MSCJ and MPA candidates must submit a 1200–1500 word, double-spaced essay, that conveys how graduate study enhances your career goals. Also discuss related qualifications, including academic preparedness, professional experience, and/or community activities, and any other significant accomplishments. Please indicate any previous experience with online education.
