** The ethics core requirement is a prerequisite for NUR 462: Nursing Capstone.

*** Statistics is required and is a pre-/corequisite for Excelsior University's NUR 430: Research in Nursing.

**** Students are eligible for NUR 462: Nursing Capstone when the ethics core requirement is complete, when they have no more than 6 credits in general education still needed, and when all other nursing courses are complete. The nursing elective is the only nursing requirement that can be taken along with the capstone course.
