Here are some subject areas typically classified as Social Sciences and History:</p> <p><i>Psychology, Economics, Sociology, Geography, Political Science, History, Anthropology</i></p>
<b>Natural Sciences and Mathematics</b>	<p>Natural Sciences and Mathematics subjects focus on understanding the natural world and problem-solving processes. Here are some subject areas typically classified as Natural Sciences and Mathematics:</p> <p><i>Anatomy and Physiology, College Algebra, Microbiology, Calculus, Chemistry, Genetics, Biology, Physics</i></p>
