A scholarship is available to a Phi Theta Kappa Member transferring to Excelsior University from a partner college. To be eligible, applicants must have no outside affiliations resulting in education support (e.g., Veterans Affairs benefits, assistance from professional organizations, etc., and have a completed current year FAFSA form). Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded. One is a regional scholarship (recipient must reside within New York State), and the other is awarded to a national recipient. The award may be applied to Excelsior University tuition and fees only. This scholarship is in addition to Excelsior's preferential partnership pricing.
