Status (attrition/ completion)	<p>Description: The attrition rates are based upon the 10/15/2019 status of students who first enrolled during FY14-18. For example, for the 37 students who started the MBA with a concentration in Accounting during the fiscal years of 2014-2018, as of 10/15/2019 10.5% of these students have completed their degree, 34.2% are still enrolled and pursuing their degrees, and 52.6% have withdrawn from the college. Completion rates reflect the percentage of degree completions at 4 years, 6 years, and 8 years after enrollment.</p> <p>Methodology: Excelsior College does not have first time, full time students and thus retention and graduation rates are not applicable measures of achievement for our students. What we have provided is a snapshot of 5 fiscal years (FY2014-2018) worth of new student enrollments and the percentage of these cohorts by concentration that have graduated, withdrawn, or are still enrolled as of the current date of 10/15/2019. Further, the completion rates are based upon the proportion of those who enrolled in the degree program and those who completed the degree within 4 years (48 months post enrollment), 6 years (72 months post enrollment), or 8 years (96 months post enrollment). Fiscal year cohorts were aggregated and for programs with at least 20 students a completion rate was provided (n/a indicates there was insufficient data to provide a completion rate for that program/year).</p>
