The Texas Board of Nursing permits Excelsior College graduates to apply for licensure in the State of Texas. Graduates who pass the NCLEX may obtain a provisional license, and obtain full licensure when either of the following two conditions are met:

1. Complete 500 hours of clinical practice under the direct supervision of an approved preceptor; or
2. Complete an educational program at an approved Texas program which is designed to assess and improve clinical skills.

If you obtain a provisional license, it will be your responsibility to meet these additional requirements to obtain full licensure. Please consider your enrollment decision in light of this information.

In order to process your undergraduate application for admission to the School of Nursing, select one of the options listed below. Then sign and return this document for processing.
