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#### **General Information**

Presented in this report are results from the exit survey.

**Exit Survey**: The exit survey collects information regarding the graduates' current employment status, future educational plans, their achievement of specific goals and Excelsior University's impact on those goals, their level of satisfaction with the University, importance and satisfaction with resources provided at Excelsior University, their achievement of general education outcomes, and achievement of the program's student learning outcomes. The survey also solicits graduates' perceptions of program strengths and suggestions for change.

Questions related to the exit survey or to the design and production of this report may be addressed to the Director of Reporting & Surveys.

**Interpreting Results:** Care should be taken in interpreting survey results. Survey results can be affected by self-selection bias, in which persons with certain characteristics or opinions are more likely to respond. Particular caution should be taken when the numbers of responses are small because results may be skewed.

Please consider the following guidelines when interpreting survey data:

<u>Means:</u> When results are expressed in a chart or table of means, please note the range of values and their meanings, which are listed in a footnote below the chart or table. In general, mean values of 4 or higher on a 6-point Likert scale are considered positive. Similarly, a mean value of 5 or higher is considered positive on a 7-point scale. Throughout the report, means are calculated only for Likert-type items that received five or more responses.

<u>Standard deviations:</u> Wherever mean values are presented, please also consider the standard deviations (SD) that accompany them. Standard deviation is a measure of variability in the response to a survey item, such that a small SD indicates less variation (more agreement) among respondents.

<u>Frequency tables:</u> As noted above, means are calculated only for Likert-type items that received five or more responses. If fewer than five were received, responses will be displayed in frequency tables, with a numerical count provided for each response. Where charts display survey items in pairs (such as ratings of program outcomes), both items will be displayed in a frequency table if either received fewer than five responses.

The graduation dates appearing on the cover of this report represent the requested report period. The dates appearing in the Sample section on page 2 indicate the range of graduation dates among actual survey respondents.

# **Exit Survey Results**

The exit survey was sent to 106 graduates. A total of 11 responded, resulting in a response rate of 9.4%. Respondents to the survey graduated between May 1, 2022 and April 30, 2023.





# **Aspects of the Excelsior University Experience**


Please indicate how <u>important</u> each aspect of the Excelsior University experience was to you and how <u>satisfied</u> you were with it. (Mean ratings)




How satisfied are you, overall, with your experiences at Excelsior University? (N = 8)

I understand that there are requirements, but in almost every class, links no longer existed to essential reading assignments, and some of the material was dated, which was frustrating when we were required to utilize references that were 5 years or less old.
